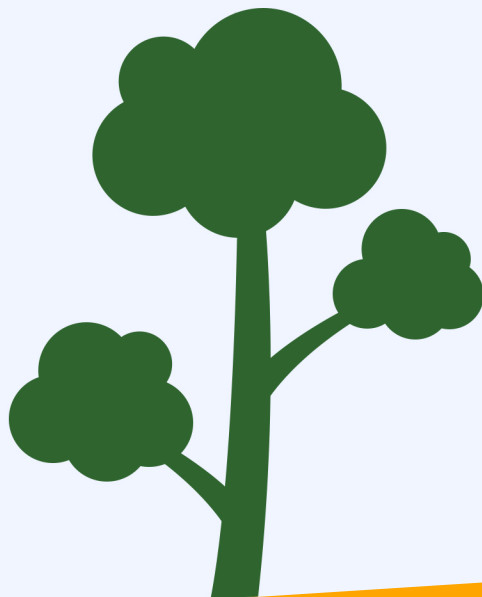
Get Involved

Texas Children's Cancer and Hematology Center (TCCHC) research is conducted in **42** different laboratories located on the Texas Children's Campus and involves over **350** researchers.



TCCHC is the largest pediatric cancer and hematology center in the United States with **160** physicians and scientists and **24** hematology and oncology fellows.



Currently, TCCHC research includes over **200** active therapeutic clinical trials. TCCHC conducts **73,700** out-patient clinic visits each year.
