The following are examples of items that groups can collect, organize, and/or assemble as a team activity to serve patients of Texas Children's Hospital West Campus.

- 1. *Bagged crayons: 3-4 crayons per bag in a small Ziploc bag.
- 2. Individual craft kits: put all materials for a craft in a ziploc bag that can be given out to patients
- 3. *Activity bags (to be given to patients ages Preschool through Teen)— include 3 or 4 items such as crayons, play-doh, small handheld games and toys, coloring books/sheets, water color sets, playing cards, princess tiaras, stickers and sticker scenes, yo-yo's, matchbox cars

- 5. Purchase (new) and bag individually in ziplocs children's and women's underwear
- 6. *Dollar store items to fill treasure/prize boxes in outpatient clinics:
 - Individual matchbox cars
 - Playing cards or card games
 - Small boxed puzzles (25-50 pieces)
 - Small action figures, i.e. Superman, Ninja Turtles
 - Fisher Price Little People
 - Small vinyl or rubber balls (diameter > 2 inches)
 - Princess crowns, tiaras, wands
 - Activity books/stickers
 - Hair accessories i.e. bows and clips
 - Small packs of crayons and small coloring books
 - Bubbles (small bottles)
 - Travel size board games
 - Kid sunglasses
 - Jumpropes
 - Notepads and fun pens
 - Dinosaur/robot flashing wands
