

Volunteer Opportunities for Main Campus

Administrative Assistance

Assist office staff with administrative duties such as: filing, copying, scanning, data entry, and phone calls. This is a great way to give back to the TCH staff and improve administrative skills!

Ambulatory Clinic

Provide play opportunities and read to outpatients in clinic waiting areas.

Activity Room

Provide an environment where inpatients can relax, do crafts, and participate in normalizing play. Activity rooms are geared towards toddlers to ten years of age.

Baby Holding

Comfort, console, and hold babies in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and other units. Must be at least 21 years of age.

Book-Video Cart

Take the Book-Video cart to patient floors for patients to check out a fun book or video.

Caring Bakers

Provide baked goods (pastries, cookies, etc...) that will be distributed to staff and family lounges as part of the Caring for the Caregiver Initiative. This is a great way to support staff and families.

Caring Critters Escort

Are you a dog lover? If so, then you can help escort the Caring Critter group to visit patients for pet therapy sessions. Available on the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month.

Child Life Assistant (Emergency Center)

Assist the Child Life staff by providing appropriate activities to patients in the Emergency Center rooms and waiting areas.

Child Life NICU Sibling Playroom

Provide an environment where siblings can relax, do crafts and participate in normalizing play.

CCC Lab Registration Desk

Assist visitors with directions to clinics and Hospital services between the Clinical Care Center and inpatient floors.

Emergency Center

Assist the EC staff by keeping exam rooms supplied and neat, transferring patients to designated areas and providing a personal touch for families and patients at a difficult time by staying with patients or siblings as needed.

First Memories

Scrapbooking in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. Volunteers take photos of infants in the NICU and teach families how to scrapbook and make decorative memory cards. Must be at least 21 years old and have a background in scrapbooking and/or photography.

Food & Nutrition

Assist with pick up and distribution of patient menus and data entry for the Food and Nutrition staff. Interest in Food & Nutrition is required.

Fun Cart

Take the Fun Cart to patient floors and provide arts & crafts, fun trinkets and things for our patients.

Healing Notes

Volunteer musicians can share their talent with patients, families, and staff, allowing them to experience the healing value of music.

Information Desk/Guest Services

Greet, assist, and provide directions to patients, visitors and staff in a welcoming manner and represent Texas Children's hospitality.

PACU/Day Surgery

Assist at the reception desk and escort families and patients to and from the Post-Anesthesia Care Unit.

Pi Beta Phi Patient/Family Library

Assist patients and parents in the use of the library. Volunteers assist in book check-outs, arts and craft tables and patient activities.

Patient Pal

Serve as a companion to patients and provide bedside activities for those are in need of a visit throughout inpatient floors.

Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation

Supervise siblings, perform general office duties and observe patients during occupation and physical therapy. Interest in physical therapy or occupational therapy is preferred.

Progressive Care Unit

Serve as a companion to patients and provide bedside activities for PCU patients. Interest in medicine, nursing, or Child Life is preferred.

Puppetry

Perform puppet shows on Saturday mornings; visit and entertain patients at bedside.

Radio Lollipop

Volunteer as part of the Radio Lollipop Team, an in-house radio station! Patients can participate on the radio, win prizes, request songs, or tell jokes on air. Volunteers can meet and greet patients in the studio or bring them arts and crafts. No radio experience needed. Only available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings.

Sno-Cone Cart

Take the Sno-Cone Cart to patients, families and staff to serve a sweet treat.

Spiritual Care

Visit with patients and families to listen and offer support. Additional training is required.

Tea Cart

Serve tea and baked goods to families and staff as part of the Caring for the Caregiver program.

Texas Children's Pediatric Office

To provide administrative and waiting room support to pediatric offices in the community. With over 40 locations there is one near you.

Toy/Gift Shop

Assist sales associates with retail duties in one of the four Auxiliary Gift Shops.
