PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

Those who feel ill or are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 **will not be admitted** into the tournament. Please check your temperature before arriving to confirm that you do not have a fever of over 100 degrees Fahrenheit. ARRIVAL

Temperature Screening: All tournament guests, vendors and volunteers will be screened at Bag Drop and must have a temperature below 100 degrees Fahrenheit.

Masking: Masks will be provided to all guests, vendors and volunteers upon arrival. Wearing masks/face coverings in outdoor crowded spaces at the tournament is **required** unless actively eating or drinking. **Per CDC guidelines**, regardless of vaccination status, masks are required at all times indoors or in fully enclosed spaces.

Social distancing: For the safety of yourself and others, please be mindful of social distancing while on-site.
